Building a Healthier Tomorrow with CMC Vellore



Federal Bank signed an MoU with Christian Medical College (CMC), Vellore to support the construction of a new College of Pharmacy on July 15th, 2025. The new pharmacy college, backed by a ₹13.73 crore grant from the Federal Bank Hormis Memorial Foundation, will span 40,476 sq ft on 2.5 acres in Bagayam, Vellore. It will be the district's first dedicated pharmacy institution, equipped with advanced labs, lecture halls, and research facilities. With an annual intake of 60 students, admissions will begin in the 2026–27 academic year.

In addition to our existing tie-ups with Assam Cancer Care Foundation, Tata Cancer Care Foundation, CMC Vellore, Reliance Foundation Trust Hospital - Mumbai, and Caritas Hospital - Kottayam, we have partnered with MVR Cancer Centre - Kozhikode, Sri Shankara Cancer Care Foundation - Bangalore, Basavatarakam Indo-American Cancer Hospital & Research Institute - Hyderabad and Bhatia Hospital - Mumbai.
