FEDERAL BANK HORMIS MEMORIAL FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS 2025-26

Applications are invited for Federal Bank Hormis Memorial Foundation Scholarship 2025-26 from students who are admitted in **first year** of their academics in the **Academic year 2025-26** for pursuing the courses mentioned below. The scholarship is instituted in memory of our Founder, Late Shri K P Hormis.

Courses Covered

Scholarships are offered for the following courses:

- MBBS
- BDS
- BVSc
- BE/ BTech/BArch
- B Sc. Nursing
- BSc Agriculture
- MBA/PGDM (Full time)

States Covered

Students who are native of the following states are eligible to apply for scholarships.

- Andhra Pradesh
- Gujarat
- Karnataka
- Kerala
- Maharashtra
- Tamil Nadu
- Telangana

Who can apply?

- Students who have secured admission under merit in the above-mentioned courses in Government/ Aided/ Government Recognised Self-financing/ Autonomous colleges.

- Students who are Dependent Wards of Martyred Armed Forces personnel and admitted in the above-mentioned courses.
- Speech/ Vision/ Hearing impaired students who have secured admission for any Degree/ Under Graduation courses or above listed professional courses.
- All applicants shall be **first year students** admitted in Academic year 2025-26 and natives of the states mentioned above.
- Annual family Income of applicants shall not exceed ₹ 3 Lakhs (Income criteria is not applicable for Dependent Wards of Martyred Armed Forces personnel).

Reservation for Physically Challenged Students

- One seat in each discipline is reserved for physically challenged students.
- If no application is received under the physically challenged category, the seat will be utilized under the general category.

How to Apply?

- Students can apply for the Scholarship through the Federal Bank Hormis Memorial Foundation Scholarship Portal

- Students are required to upload the following documents while applying:
 - a. Photo of the student (Passport size, shall be less than 500 kb in .jpeg format)
 - b. Admission Letter/ Admission Memo
 - c. Course fee structure
 - d. Mark sheets of Qualifying Examination
 - e. Instructions from the University for converting the CGPA/ Grade into percentage (Mandatory for MBA Applicants)
 - f. Family income certificate issued by government authorities.
 - g. Nativity certificate.

- h. ID proof & Address proof of Student and Parents.
- i. Medical Certificate (applicable for physically challenged students & speech/ hearing/ vision impaired students).
- j. In the case of dependant wards of Martyred Armed Forces Personnel who lost their life while serving the nation, evidence showing the same needs to be submitted.

Process Flow

- Applicants will be shortlisted based on the marks scored in the qualifying examination and income criteria stipulated.
- Shortlisted applicants will be called in for an interaction at Zonal Offices/ Designated Offices for the verification of documents and confirming the eligibility for the scholarship.
- Based on the inputs, Federal Bank's CSR Dept will review and publish the final list of eligible candidates in the Bank's website.

Points of Reference for applicants

- Qualifying examination is **12th** Standard in the case of Graduation course applicants and **Graduation** in case of MBA applicants.
- Medical Certificates are applicable for Physically Challenged students and Speech/ vision/ hearing impaired students and these certificates (showing at least 40 percent disability) shall be issued by a Medical officer not below the rank of DMO or an approved Medical Officer of the Bank.
- While applying, all the documents except the Passport size photograph of the student shall be uploaded in pdf format and maximum size shall be 300kb.
- Students are requested to take a printout of applications submitted in the portal for future reference.
- The Selection of scholarship awardees will be based on marks scored in qualifying examination and personal interview.
- Application once submitted is final and will be accepted only through online mode. Multiple applications by an applicant will not be entertained. Incomplete Applications will not be accepted.
- Once shortlisted, only those candidates attending the interaction will be considered for the final selection process.

- Shortlisted candidates will be invited for interaction at the 'Preferred City' selected by them during the application submission.
- Decision of the Bank/ Foundation regarding selection of students and in all matters in this regard will be final and binding.

Last date of submission of online application is 31st December 2025.

Scholarship Distribution

- Selected students will be reimbursed 100% of tuition fees and other educational expenses as per the college fee structure.
- Reimbursement is subject to a maximum of ₹ 1 Lakh per year throughout the normal course period.
- Students are eligible for one PC/ Laptop/ Tablet during their course of study.
 - Maximum reimbursement for PC/ Laptop: ₹ 40,000.
 - Maximum reimbursement for Tablet: ₹ 30,000.
 - Overall eligibility remains within ₹ 1 Lakh per year.
